## Research Highlights

### Music for Character Dance: Authentic Foundations & Expanded Resources

With initial grant support sought in 2022, this research focuses on developing an expanded repertoire of music for character dance accompaniment. The final dissemination of this research will be to provide a broader scope of character dance music via an accompaniment album with global perspectives and authentic resources for enhancing classical ballet pedagogy.

#### Juxtaposing Dance Forms of the Caucasus for Cross-Cultural Communication

Identifying stylistic connections between ballet and ethnic dance forms of Armenia, Azerbaijan, and Georgia; and using this material to promote communication and understanding amongst ethnic groups through dance. "Gantiadi" and "Samaia" developed in 2014, with further development as part of CDE repertoire and community engagement in 2021 and 2022. Primary source research for Azerbaijani and Georgian dance forms in 2015 and 2017, with "Yalli: Isti Ruh" and "Gragnili Biliki" presented in 2017.

Analyzing how classical ballet and world dance forms can best serve a broader community through case studies and experience with programs such as ArtsBridge (2008), Character Dance Ensemble (2003-Present), Eastern Arts (2003-Present), Into the Arts (1999-2002), Murray School District (2017), and Turnaround Arts (2012).
