Course Description: This course is designed to introduce ballet majors to technologies relevant to their field. Topics include lighting design, video projection, sound design, recording and editing.

My Role: I taught ballet majors how to film and edit video using Adobe Premiere and/or Final Cut Pro X. Along with this they also learned how to do basic audio edits in GarageBand. The goal was to give them the skills they needed to edit audition reels and to create new musical tracks for their choreographic work.

I also taught the students how to film live performances, including all of the theoretical devices that can be used when filming a show live, especially dance. The goal of my teaching sections were to give the students useful knowledge so that they can better understand and communicate with technical staff when creating works for the stage.
